## Press Release

unsichtbar is an intermedial and interdisciplinary symposium against sexualized violence, which will take place from 08 to 19 March 2022 at Never at Home, Schellinggasse 13 Vienna. It is intended to be an emotional as well as professional confrontation with the topic and to refer to the individual, but also societal effects. Within the framework of an exhibition, which shows different artistic positions, a panel discussion, which mediates on a content level and various workshops, which deal with aspects of sexualized violence.

Sexualized violence is a widespread problem and can occur in various, often hidden forms! None of them should be judged and every form of sexualized violence should be taken seriously in their individuality. Nevertheless, sexualized violence is still invisible in our society. The unsichtbar team wants to change that! unsichtbar makes sexualized violence visible! In doing so, unsichtbar wants to deal with and pick up on situations that are often trivialized in society; and yet have serious effects on those affected.

unsichtbar creates an intermedial, interdisciplinary discourse by being a voice for those affected and make the society aware of the consequences of sexualized violence - on an individual and societal level. unsichtbar shows that the resulting traumas or psychological injuries are often far more serious than those affected and their relatives are aware of and can also have social repercussions.

unsichtbar turns the blind eye and social inaction into awareness and support.

### EXHIBITION

The exhibition within the framework of unsichtbar shows works by various artists on the topic. Through the different artworks the feeling or the state of mind after sexually abusive experiences is getting tangible. The artistic works, which cover a wide range (photography, literature, sound and space installations), provide visitors with an insight into the mindset of those affected. Art as a communication tool is used here to raise public as well as personal awareness in addressing sexualized violence against women\*.

### PANEL DISCUSSION

The panel discussion, moderated by Helena Gabriel-Oiwoh (unsichtbar), offers an interdisciplinary interaction between artists and experts on the topic. In terms of content, the panel discussion will focus on what must/should be done to make sexualized violence against women visible and why. All panelists pursue diverse "strategies of visibility" and work on very different levels - and yet each one of them does an important contribution. On the panel are Clara Bohmann (clara.comments), Gloria Bozyigit (UN Women Austria), Livia Klein (unsichtbar) and Eva Teja Tschiderer (Embodiment Coach).

### WORKSHOPS

A special interest of unsichtbar is the inclusion of girls and young women with workshops especially designed for this target group.
